SGM received the final shariah certification in financing commodity Murabaha via Tawarruq on 29 August 2024. This will affect new loan applications and SGM will be planning a soft launch by the end of FY2024.

Ustaz Muhammad Zhahiruddin Mohd Zuhri proceeded to explain what Tawarruq is to the members.


